I, Ella C. Sloss County Clerk and ex-officio clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Modoc County, California do hereby certify that a petition to establish the above named fire protection district was regularly granted on the 18th day of February, 1946 after due and legal notice of the time and place of hearing having been given as required by law, said Fire Protection District boundaries being described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the State line common to the States of California and Nevada, with the southern boundary line of the State of Oregon, a point identical with the northeast corner of Modoc County;

Thence westerly and following the said state line common to the states of California and Oregon to the summit of the Warner Range of Mountains;

Thence southerly and westerly and following the said summit of said Warner Range of Mountains to a point at or near the southwest corner of Section 12, in Township 45 North, Range 15 East M.D.M a point identical with the northwest corner of the Lake City Fire District;

Thence easterly and following the various section lines which also bound and form the northerly boundary line of the said Lake City Fire District, to an intersection with the said state line common to the states of California and Nevada;

Thence northerly and following the said state line common to the States of California and Nevada to the intersection with the southern boundary line of the State of Oregon, the point of beginning.
