“Open Burning Allowed Without A Permit”

Susanville – On Monday, December 21, 2020, the CAL FIRE Lassen Modoc Unit transitioned out of peak fire season. This means if you live in state responsibility areas within Lassen, Modoc or Plumas County, you may burn without a permit after contacting your Air Pollution Control District to ensure it is a permissive burn day.

To find out if it is a burn day, contact your local Air Pollution Control District (APCD).

You are responsible for maintaining control of your fire and must be in attendance while burning. Anyone allowing a fire to escape their control can be held criminally and civilly responsible.
