Modoc Joint Unified School District agrees with finding #2:

Modoc Joint Unified School District, according to the existing Memorandum of Understanding with Modoc Charter School, has a representative who sits on the Charter School Board of Trustees. In an effort to improve our oversight of the Charter School Operations, MJUSD has changed its representative who sits on the board.

Response to Recommendation #1:

On June 30, 2009, the Modoc Charter School Memorandum of Understanding with Modoc Joint Unified School District is up for renewal. It is the intent of MJUSD to review this document closely and include language to address MCS accountability. The MJUSD will utilize legal counsel opinions prior to implementing our MOU with Modoc Charter School.
